- Makers' Day: HSV offers one-on-one workshops on weaving, spinning, chair seat weaving, and basic woodworking. Full descriptions of on-demand workshops available <u>online</u>.
- Fall Specialty Tours: Hancock Shaker Village offers a variety of specials tours, including but not limited to Introduction to the Village, Shaker Spirituality, and Shaker Architecture. HSV also offers the option to Create Your Own Shaker Adventure where visitors can also call to create and schedule their own specialty tour of choice.
- <u>Exhibitions</u>: Hancock Shaker Village offers a variety of changing and permanent exhibitions. From artifacts in authentic room settings to ground breaking contemporary art, the museum offers something for everyone. Featured exhibitions include Anything But Simple, Silo Songs, and Altered Visions.
- o <u>Goat Yoga</u>: It's here to namaste. Bleat in. Bleat out. We kid you not. You'd better goat used to it. Bring a mat, towel, and open mind.
- Morning Moving Meditation: A simple moving meditation to wake your senses, explore the connection between mind and body, and appreciate the grounds anew with dancer Katie Workum, whose inventive work has been described as "thrilling" (Brooklyn Rail), "whimsical" (The New York Times) and "delightful" (The New Yorker). This group meditation and guided movement workshop parallels the Shaker practice of spiritual movement. This class is open to all.
- o <u>The Mastheads</u>: Explore and write in five studios, designed by architects Tessa Kelly and Chris Parkinson, that architecturally interpret the Berkshire studios of authors, Nathaniel Hawthorne, Oliver Wendell Holmes Sr., Henry Wadsworth Longfellow, Herman Melville, and Henry David Thoreau, who wrote in Pittsfield and connect with the region's literary history.
