The Cantilena Chamber Choir is the Berkshire region's leading a cappella ensemble, in residence at Trinity Church in Lenox, MA.

HUMANITIES EXPERTISE

The Choir has been heard on a special WMHT Christmas Eve radio broadcast of Lessons and Carols recorded at Trinity Church in Lenox. The Choir has collaborated with the New England Barogue Soloists, Aston Magna, The Empire Brass, Shakespeare & Company, the Lenox Library and the Berkshire Immigrant Center. Past season highlights include a performance of the silent film The Passion of Joan of Arc with live orchestra and choir, a program for the Tanglewood Music Center 75th Anniversary year, a concert of Shaker songs performed for the Hancock Shaker Village 50th Anniversary gala; a concert of works by Shostakovich; and programs for children such as Kids 4 harmony. The Choir is in residence at Trinity Church, Lenox and it is a recipient of two Choral Arts New England's Alfred Nash Patterson awards. It is also the recipient of an ongoing prestigious Peers grant from the Massachusetts Cultural Arts Council for its outstanding Martin Luther King Spirituals open sings and concerts.
